## Press Release 8/14

The Federal Bureau of Maritime Casualty Investigation (BSU) hereby gives notice that the interim report pertaining to the serious marine casualty involving the ATLANTIC CARTIER on 1 May 2013 in the port of Hamburg was published. The interim report provides information about the subject of the investigation and the status of the joint investigation being carried out with the Swedish investigation authority SHK.

Serious marine casualty – Fire onboard the ATLANTIC CARTIER

On 1 May 2014 a fire broke out in a closed vehicles deck onboard the Swedish flagged ConRo vessel ATLANTIC CARTIER in the port Hamburg. The brandnew vehicles stowed there were destroyed. persons were injured. Following an unsuccessful attempt to fight the fire by shipboard resources the vessels command summoned the aid of brigade the fire Hamburg. fire The brigade managed to prevent the fire from spreading to further parts of the vessel and cargo deploying extensive forces. The fire was extinguished after a fire-fighting operation of about 9 hours.
