Today, the BSU published its Annual Report 2020. The report provides an overview of the activities in the last year. The core part of the report is the presentation of selected current investigations, some of which are concluded. The second emphasis is laid on the detailed statistics in the second part of the report. By using the European Marine Casualty Information Platform (EMCIP), the BSU was enabled to look more closely at some accident causes. The number of notifications and marine casualties is constant.

This year, the part „public relations” covers a broad spectrum. The international investigation report involving the loss of containers on the MSC ZOE attracted lively interest and subsequent dissemination in the media. It became clear, that the activity of the BSU is perceived as an important aspect of the improvement of maritime safety.
